



KaganUK Live Online Workshop

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What is the content of the workshop?

The workshop is a Live Online version of Kagan's signature training, ***Kagan Cooperative Learning***.

How is this format different from Kagan's face-to-face workshops?

This live online workshop is conducted by a Master KaganUK Trainer in real-time using Zoom. Participants log in individually and may participate in the workshop from the comfort of their own homes/classrooms using a computer, tablet, or smartphone with an Internet connection, working camera, and microphone. Computers are preferred due to the larger screen size. In contrast to in-person Kagan workshops in which teachers interact in teams, in the Live Online version the trainer leads participants through the structures, shows and analyses numerous videos of the structures in action in real classrooms, and processes the structures with participants.

Which days of training are currently available?

CL Days 1-4 are available in this Live Online version. Plus a growing number of additional Kagan Courses e.g. Kagan Structures for EYFS (Little Ones). Ask Gavin or Joanna about additional KaganUK workshops.

A Typical Full Day Schedule is :

- **Session 1** – 8:45 to 10:15 (1.5 hrs)
- **Morning Break** – 10:15 to 10:30 (15 mins)
- **Session 2** – 10:30 to 12:00 (1.5 hrs)
- **Lunch Break** – 12:00 to 12:30 (30 mins)
- **Session 3** – 12:30 – 2:30 (2 hrs)

Each Full Day Workshop content can also be delivered via two 2.5 Hour Sessions.

Who can participate in the Live Online workshop?

All participants who are pre-registered for the workshop may view the live workshop. The host and/or participants are not permitted to record the workshop.

How does the host pre-register participants for the workshop?

For Whole Staff training, KaganUK provides the host with a link to be distributed to staff participating in the event. For Open Enrolment Events, individuals or small groups can book online for their preferred dates.

How do participants join the workshop?

Before the workshop, KaganUK will email participants an invitation to participate in the workshop. The invitation will include a link, a unique invitation code, and details about the workshop. Invitations will be sent at least 48 hours prior to the workshop.

Do participants need a Zoom account or Zoom software?

Participant may use their existing Zoom account or create a free account, but neither are required. When participants click KaganUK's emailed invitation link, they will be prompted to download the Zoom software. Participants simply enter the code provided in the KaganUK invitation email.

What course materials are required and how do participants receive materials?

KaganUK will either ship materials to the host to distribute to participants in advance of the workshop or send a digital version of the course materials. The required materials for each participant are:

- KaganUK Cooperative Learning Training Booklet
