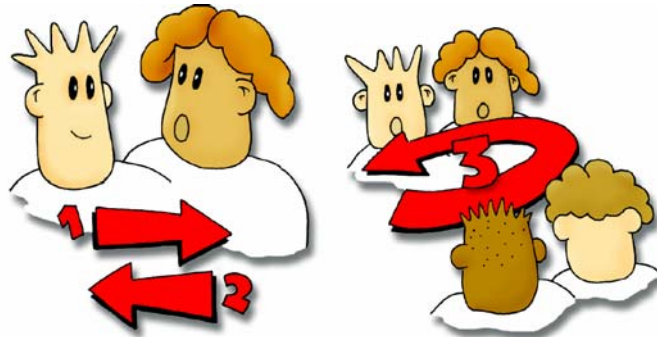




Three-Step Interview.



Students interview a partner and then share with teammates what they have learned.

- 1 Teacher assigns the interview topic and states the duration of the interview.
- 2 Teacher calls for Think Time.
- 3 In pairs, Student A interviews Student B.
- 4 Pairs switch roles: Student B interviews Student A.
- 5 Pairs pair to form groups of four.
- 6 RoundRobin: Each student in turn shares with the team what he/she learned in the interview.

During a Three-Step Interview each teammate has the chance to be the interviewer, the interviewee and the reporter. This is a great structure for getting to know your teammates. Below is a list of great questions to get you started.
